STEWARDSHIP & TALENTS...

Parishioner Vicki Wood

The three traditional legs on the stool of stewardship are listed most often as TIME, TALENT, AND TREASURE. There are many members of our faith community who have many talents, and they share them generously, a fact which makes us the vibrant and caring parish we are.

Sometimes, however, our people have talents which might not seem so obvious in the ways they serve God. One of those people is **Vicki Wood**. Vicki is 90 years old and cannot use her God-given talents as she once did, but use them well she did.

At a time long before our current well known female race car drivers, Vicki was the best female driver in the United States and maybe even in the world. She discovered her talent in Michigan in the early 1950's, when she participated in what was called a Powder Puff Derby, and she clearly had talents well beyond those of her female counterparts in the race. She became the pre-eminent female NASCAR driver of the era.

Vicki's name is still in the NASCAR record books. In 1956 she was second in the two-way flying mile with a speed of 136.081. That same year she had the fastest one-way run in measured mile history -- 143.827. In 1958 and 1959 she won the Pure Oil Performance Trials in the passing test against male competition, and in 1959 set a new (all drivers) measured mile record of 147.420. She holds the woman's record for the measured mile (150.375), the woman's record at Daytona International Speedway (130.379) and the woman's record at Atlanta International Raceway (121.30).

She is still often found at NASCAR events, especially in Daytona. We are proud to have Vicki as part of our parish family.



STEWARDSHIP & SAINT MARTHA...

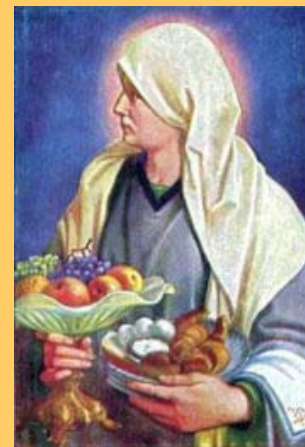
Next Wednesday, July 29, is the Feast Day of St. Martha. She is one of the best examples of stewardship in action which we may have. The patron saint of domestic workers, cooks, housewives, and hospitality among other things, Saint Martha's willingness to serve the Lord is well documented.

The Lord was apparently a frequent guest in the home of Martha, her sister Mary, and her brother Lazarus, as three visits are documented in scripture, and in relation to one it is said, "Jesus loved Martha and Mary and Lazarus."

Although Martha demonstrates her unhappiness with her sister not helping her, it is important to note how the third visit of the Lord is described. In it Lazarus is brought back to life; Mary causes a bit of a reaction when she anoints Jesus with expensive perfume; as for Martha, it merely says, "Martha served."

Martha is not highlighted; she is not cited for some extraordinary act; she is not involved in a miracle. She simply serves Jesus. We are all called to serve—that's stewardship.

“ROCK THE UNIVERSE”**

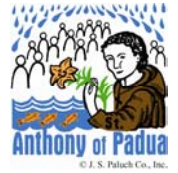
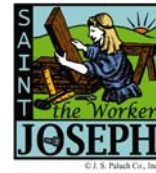

MIRACULOUS MEDAL**

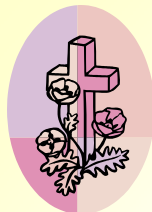
